New Services and Facilities

Relocation of Computer Rooms

Computer Room 442 (on the 4th Floor) of the LRC had been relocated to Room 107A (on the 1st Floor). All hardware and software configurations of Room 107A is the same as that in the Room 442.



New Freebooking Computer Room

As from the Spring Semester commences, starting from 27th January 2011, Room 107D is served as a freebooking computer room (with seats for 30 PCs). The opening hours is from 9:00am to 5:00pm from Monday to Friday (close for lunch time 11:30am to 12:45pm) during Term time.

Software Upgrade to MS Office 2007

Before the Spring Semester starts, all PCs in the LRC have been upgraded to Microsoft Office 2007.



Print Access Control System

The PaperCut Print Access Control System has been scheduled to be installed in the LRC Computer Rooms in March 2011.



Additional Notebook Computers

The LRC had acquired 15 new notebook computers in January 2011 for improvement of the loan service.

New Folding Doors

Two folding doors had been installed on G/F and 1/F of the LRC to separate the 2 V-shaped areas from the main LRC for energy saving purposes during non-peak opening hours and for other campus events/activities.



Replacement of Wireless LAN Access Points

The replacement work of 10 sets of Wireless LAN access points (802.11n) in improving the access performance would be done in February 2011.

New Binding Facilities

A manual plastic comb binding machine was acquired and has been installed inside the Multimedia Zone of the LRC for use since the Spring Semester.



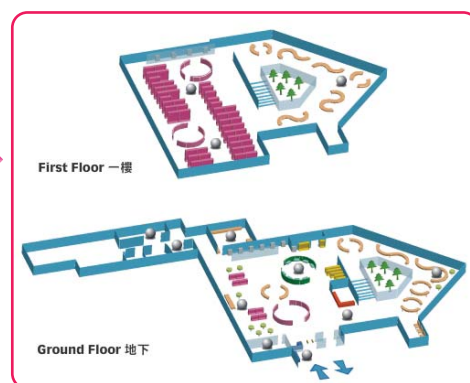
New Black/White Digital Copier

A new black/white digital copier has been installed on 1/F of the LRC to meet the demand of users before the Chinese New Year.

Hardware Upgrade at Teaching Venues

Replacements for those PCs purchased in 2004-05 at various teaching venues supported by the LRC would be arranged in two phases. The first phase had been completed before the Spring Semester in replacing 27 PC base units equipped with Intel Core i5 750 (2.66GHz) processors while the second phase would replace another 19 sets of base units with similar processors by the end of March 2011.

Opening Hours during Term Break

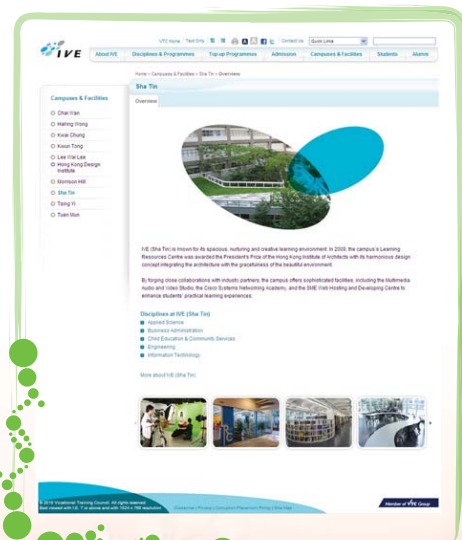
