

New Services and Facilities

Digital Signage System Replacement

The Digital Signage System had been replaced by a new system in April 2013, with more and better features. The new system could show the news feeds from RTHK and support more media formats with higher screen quality.

Acquisition of Facilities

With a view to increasing the seating capacity, two additional red sofas have been purchased and placed in the V-shape studying area on the

1/F of the LRC Complex since May 2013. More book trolleys would be purchased to enhance the LRC facilities in the academic year 2013-2014.





Replacement of PCs in LRC

About 30 outdated PCs were replaced in the LRC Complex in June 2013.

Extension of Opening Hours in the Free-booking Room 107D

With the assistance from the student helpers, the free-booking service at Computer Room 107D had been extended until 6:30 pm with two sessions per week (every Tuesday and Thursday) during February to June 2013. The extended hours would be effective in this academic year during IVE term time.





New Services and Facilities

Weather Monitoring System

The Weather Monitoring System has been installed in two (the one near Stair A and B) of our six outlets of the Digital Signage System (DSS) since 29 July 2013. Information such as Solar Irradiation, Temperature and Wind Speed would be captured for real time display.

Software Upgrade in LRC

To facilitate the learning and teaching

requirement for the Applied Science department, freeware DIALux 4.11.0.3 have been installed at the designated 5 PCs in the LRC Complex since August 2013. The new version of Adobe CS6 would be installed for all PCs in the LRC Complex and ready by December 2013.

New Projectors in Lecture Theatres and Annex Hall

To further improve the multimedia teaching facilities, the projectors in the Lecture Theatres 029, 030 and Annex Hall had been replaced by new ones in August 2013.

Additional Blu-ray Players

For enhancement of audio-visual facilities, all TVs have been installed with the new Blu-ray players to deliver media materials in CD/VCD/DVD/Blu-ray disks at the Independent Learning Corner and Audio-Visual Room in the LRC Complex since early September 2013.

Study Aid (CCTV, 閱讀放大器) in the LRC for Visually Impaired Students

A new model of Study Aid (CCTV, 閱讀放大器) has been set up in the LRC for Visually Impaired Students since 18 September 2013 near the main entrance of the LRC Complex. The CCTV is a LCD



Monitor with a camera mounted at the top to capture the characters of a document and show them on the monitor with the size that can be adjusted to assist students' reading and study. Students could contact our Counter Staff for assistance when necessary.

Network Equipment Upgrade

Some portion of the network equipment would be upgraded in December 2013 with a view to enhance the network performance in the campus.

Staff members could have the access rights and use the facilities inside the libraries when presenting these cards.



Training Session for SHAPE Students

An e-resources workshop had been arranged for the SHAPE students of Higher Diploma in Health and Wellness Business course of the Department of Business Administration on 25 July 2013. There were totally 32 students and 3 teachers attending the workshop. Students attended the workshop had received hand-on training on using various e-databases such as ProQuest, Medline, WiseNews and Books 24x7, etc.

Page One Bookstore Membership Cards for IVE(ST) staffs

Besides the three Commercial Press Gold Membership Cards, a Page One Bookstore Membership Card for staff members was also available and it had been placed at the LRC Circulation Counter. VTC staff members could borrow these cards to buy books, audio-visual items and stationeries at the book stores with different discounts.





Re-arrangement of the Main Collection on the 1/F of the LRC Complex

All the materials of LRC main had collection been reorganized and systematically shelved on the 1/F during the summer vacation. The old and outdated materials such as Chinese fictions. Reference Books. Examination Papers (e.g. HKCEE, HKAL, ACCA) with publication year before 2007 of low viewing value had been removed from the shelves during this summer.



Improvement of the Air Quality of the Seminar/Project Rooms

Maintenance work of the ventilation system had been carried out in the five Seminar and Project Rooms in August 2013. The air conditioners were overhauled and cleaned while the exhaust fans of the three Project Rooms had been replaced with bigger size to improve the air quality of the rooms.
