Replacement of Staff PCs in Classrooms and Meeting Venues

To improve the multimedia facilities provided by the LRC, a total of 62 sets of staff PCs had been replaced in various teaching venues including classrooms, seminar rooms, tutorial rooms, lecture theatres, Annex Hall and meeting venues in August 2021. With the upgraded hardware and software, the average login time for the new PCs had been shortened to around two minutes now.

Real Time People Counting System

To minimize the risk of COVID-19 virus spreading and to implement crowd control and social distancing in LRC, the Real Time People Counting System had been installed in the Academic Year 2021/22 to count the number of people in the LRC Complex. With the System, two LCD displays near the entrance/exit would show the current number of people in the LRC Complex. That number would be updated simultaneously when people enter or leave the LRC Complex.

Self-pickup Station

A new Self-pickup Station with 24 lockers is located near the entrance of the LRC Complex. It enables ST students and staff to pick up books they request without entering LRC. When a requested item is ready to be picked up at the station, patron will receive the email notification and pick up the requested item(s) at his/her own convenience.

Mobile Print at FujiFilm Photocopiers

The mobile app "Print Utility V3" (by FujiFilm formerly Fuji Xerox) is available to provide the Print function to deliver Mobile Print service. Patron needs to set up this app on his/her own smartphone (i.e. iPhone or Android phone) with NFC function and connect with campus WiFi. Patron can then print out documents or photos in the phone at one of the photocopiers (Octopus payment) through the campus WiFi. The app supports various file formats including PDF, TIFF, JPEG and XDW.









Digital Whiteboards in Teaching Venues

To set up interactive classrooms proposed by the Digital Future Office, 10 sets of PRO-X86 digital whiteboards had been provided in classrooms (Room 201, 217, N108A) and Departmental venues since July 2021. 

Two Factor Authentication for Students


To enhance the security level, Two Factor Authentication (2FA) had been enforced to the following student's services when they access from non-VTC network.

- 2. Email and Microsoft 365 Services (Including Exchange Online, MS Teams, SharePoint, OneDrive, MS Office, etc.) (Apply to Mobile App and Desktop Client) (Enforcement date: 13 September 2021)
- 3. Email and Microsoft 365 Services (Including Exchange Online, MS Teams, SharePoint, OneDrive, MS Office, etc.) (Apply to all methods, including web browser) (Enforcement date: 1 November 2021)

Please register VTC Student 2FA with below steps to protect your CNA and information.
