New Color Photocopiers for Printing/Photocopying/Scanning

In the Academic Year 2020-21, six new color photocopiers with Octopus consoles had been installed in providing printing, photocopying and scanning services. Users can make use of mobile phones to submit print jobs and receive scanned copies.

New "Print Quota" Printing Service

Three new "Print Quota" printers had been installed at the LRC Complex in the Academic Year 2020-21. Students can enjoy free printing of black-and-white materials with papers provided. For A4 and A3 printing, 2 quotas per page and 4 quotas per page will be deducted respectively.

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New Servicesand Facilities

Borrowing Service of Laptops and Tablets

Over 200 sets of laptops and tablets had been provided for borrowing service. They include 14-inch laptops, 10.5-inch iPads and 10.2-inch Android tablets. The borrowing periods include one-day loan, short term loan (2 weeks) and long term loan (by referral only). Through the Notebook Computer Loan Scheme, students with financial needs can apply to borrow notebook computers on long-term loan. After assessment by Student Development Office (SDO), the eligible students can borrow notebook computers on 6-month loan.

Replacement of PCs in V-Shape Area

For enhancement of the computing facilities in V-Shape of LRC Complex, over 80 sets of old PCs and LED monitors had been replaced by PCs in small form factor and 21.5" LED monitors in 16:9 scale respectively in February 2021.

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New Software and Hardware in Teaching Venues

In response to the change of face-to-face classes to online lessons since February 2020, webcams and Microsoft Teams had been newly installed in teaching venues such as classrooms, tutorial rooms, seminar rooms and lecture theatres for delivery of online teaching activities.

Enhancement on Multimedia Facilities in Hall

For enhancement on the multimedia facilities in Hall, installation of the new projector and projection screen had been performed in early September 2020. Laser technology had been adopted in the new projector to provide higher image quality and the projection screen had been extended to create larger viewing area for presentation.

Pull-up Banners in Canteen and Café

To minimize the risk of COVID-19 spreading, new pull-up banners made of transparent materials had been designed and installed at Canteen and Café in June 2020.



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Online Lessons and Video Recording in Meeting Rooms

To provide additional facilities for online teaching and video recording/production, new equipment items such as LED ring lights and external microphones had been newly installed in the Meeting Room 418, 507 and 505B since November 2020. 

Special Arrangement of LRC during COVID-19

In view of the development of COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 onwards, LRC had implemented the following arrangement and preventive measures:

- Installation of acrylic partitions in the LRC Complex and all computer rooms;
- Provide hand sanitizers at service counters, main entrance and staff area;
- All users must wear face masks inside LRC;
- Discussion rooms are kept closed;
- Limit the seating capacity and to keep social destancing;
- Limit the number of patrons inside the LRC Complex;
- Use of the GULU system to control queuing and prevent crowding at the main entrance of the LRC Complex;
- Adhere to social distancing and personal hygiene in public areas and staff area;
- Frequent sanitizing and cleaning of facilities in public areas;
- Provide 10 sets of Online Learning Cubicles;
- Extension of due date of books and laptops introduced to prevent unexpected fines during LRC temporary closure


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Online LRC e-Resources Workshop




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Leganto - New Reading List Tool in Moodle
